ORDER CLOSING THE SUBSIDIARY CASES

This matter coming before the Court on the Motion of the Reorganized Debtors for the Entry of an Order Closing the Subsidiary Cases (the "Motion");¹ the Court having reviewed the Motion and no objections having been filed; the Court having found that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and Article X of the Plan, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b) and (c) notice of the Motion was sufficient under the circumstances; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The chapter 11 cases of Swift Energy USA, Inc. (Case No. 15-12669); Swift Energy International, Inc. (Case No. 15-12671); Swift Energy Group, Inc. (Case No. 15-12672); Swift Energy Alaska, Inc. (Case No. 15-12673); Swift Energy Operating, LLC (Case No. 15-12674); GASRS LLC (Case No. 15-12675); Swenco Western, LLC (Case No. 15-12676); and Swift Energy Exploration Services, Inc. (Case No. 15-12677) are hereby CLOSED.
3. The case of Swift Energy Company, Case No. 15-12670 (MFW), shall remain open pending further order of this Court.
4. The Clerk of this Court shall enter this Order individually on each of the dockets of the above-captioned chapter 11 cases and each of the dockets of the Subsidiary Cases shall be marked as "Closed."
5. The Reorganized Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Order in accordance with the Motion.

¹ Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Motion.

6. Entry of this Order is without prejudice to the rights of the Reorganized Debtors or any party in interest to reopen the Subsidiary Cases for cause.

7. Entry of this Order shall have no effect whatsoever on any contested or other matters pending before this Court.


8. Following entry of this Order, the caption for Case No. 15-12670 (MFW) shall read as follows:
