ORDER APPROVING U.S. SECURITIES & EXCHANGE COMMISSION'S MOTION TO CHANGE VENUE¹

This matter came on for hearing before the Court on both May 2, 2014 and May 6, 2014 pursuant to the U.S. Securities & Exchange Commission's ("SEC") motion for an order changing the venue of the instant cases to the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, District of Massachusetts, Central Division, (the "Motion"). (ECF No. 67). Debtors TelexFree, LLC, TelexFree, Inc., and

1 TelexFree Financial, Inc. (collectively the "Debtors") opposed the Motion. (ECF No. 120). The 2 SEC docketed a Reply. (ECF No. 143). Gregory E. Garman and Teresa M. Pilatowicz, of 3 Gordon Silver, Nancy A. Mitchell and Joseph P. Davis, of Greenberg Traurig, appeared on 4 behalf of Debtors. J. Michal Bloom appeared on behalf of the United States Trustee. Athanasios 5 Agelakopoulos appeared on behalf of Tracy Hope Davis, United States Trustee for Region 17. 6 Sandra Lavigna, Deena R. Bernstein, and Frank C. Huntington appeared on behalf of the U.S. 7 Securities & Exchange Commission. Other appearances were noted on the record. 8 The Court has reviewed the SEC's Motion; Debtor's objection thereto and the supporting declaration of Stuart A. MacMillan; and the reply filed by SEC. To the extent that the Court 9 10 admitted documents and witness testimony into evidence during the May 2, 2014 hearing, that 11 evidence is incorporated into this written order pursuant to FED. R. CIV. P. 52, made applicable 12 to this matter pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014(c) and 7052. Additionally, to the extent that the 13 Court and made findings of fact and conclusions of law on the record during the May 6, 2014 14 hearing, those findings of fact and conclusions of law are incorporated into this written order 15 pursuant to FED. R. CIV. P. 52, made applicable to this matter pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 16 9014(c) and 7052. 17 The Court has also considered the arguments of counsel at the May 2, 2014 hearing, and 18 is fully advised as to the issues pending before it. The court finds that it has jurisdiction over this 19 matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; this is a core matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 20 157(b)(2); and venue is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1408(1) as to TelexFree, 21 LLC and pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1408(2) as to TelexFree Financial, Inc. 22 Based upon the record before the Court: 23 **IT IS ORDERED** that the Motion to change venue be and hereby is **GRANTED**. 24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all of the Debtors' jointly administered cases are 25 transferred to the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, District of Massachusetts, Central Division.

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
