ORDER STAYING ADVERSARY PROCEEDINGS

WHEREAS, Stephen Darr, the chapter 11 trustee of the debtors in the main case, filed a motion to stay adversary proceedings nos. 14-4044 and 14-4057 to which Middlesex Savings Bank, in adversary proceeding no. 14-4044, filed a limited opposition; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2014, adversary proceeding no. 14-4080 was commenced; and

WHEREAS, currently pending before the United States District Court for the District of Massachusetts are motions to withdraw the reference in adversary proceedings nos. 14-4044 and 14-4057.

NOW, THEREFORE, for the reasons more fully set forth in the trustee's motions to stay, filed in adversary proceedings nos. 14-4044 and 14-4057, including that on July 1, 2014 a motion for transfer and consolidation of six related actions was filed with and is currently pending before the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation, and the stipulation among the plaintiffs and the trustee with respect to the trustee's motion to stay filed in adversary proceeding 14-4057 and in the interests of judicial economy and for good cause, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- Adversary proceedings nos. 14-4044 and 14-4057 are stayed pending further order of the court.
- 2. The hearings scheduled for August 28, 2014 on the trustee's motions to stay in adversary proceedings nos. 14-4044 and 14-4057 are canceled.
- The hearing scheduled for September 23, 2014 on the motion of defendant Randy N.
 Crosby to dismiss or in the alternative to stay in adversary proceeding no. 14-4057 is canceled.

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- 4. Counsel for the plaintiffs in adversary proceeding no. 14-4080 shall file a statement with the court by September 11, 2014, as to whether the actions currently pending before the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation are related to the claims asserted in adversary proceeding 14-4080 and whether adversary proceeding 14-4080 should also be stayed.
- 5. Counsel for the plaintiffs in adversary proceeding nos. 14-4044 and 14-40 .57 shall file a statement as to actions taken by the Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation and a copy of any order or decision issued by the Panel within 7 days of the Panel's taking such action.
