- 1. The Motion is granted.
- 2. No just reason for delay exists to enter the Judgment as a final judgment against Defendants Leila Tatiana Xavier, Chris Araujo, Jorge Lopes, Enerstina Xavier, Atanazia Xavier,

3. Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 7055(b) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy

Procedure and MLBR 7055-1, final Judgment shall be and hereby is entered on this date, with

respect to the complaint (the "Complaint") filed by of Stephen B. Darr (the "Plaintiff" or

"Trustee"), the duly-appointed trustee of the Chapter 11 estates of TelexFree, LLC, TelexFree, Inc.,

and TelexFree Financial, Inc. (the "Debtors") initiating this adversary proceeding on or about April

1, 2016, in favor of the Trustee against the Defendants as follows:

(i) On Count I of the Complaint, judgment enters in favor of the Trustee and any liens

asserted by the Defendants are hereby determined invalid against property of the

Debtors' chapter 11 estates pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 544.

(ii) On Count II of the Complaint, judgment enters in favor of the Trustee avoiding the

Defendants' attempted perfection of security interests by the filing of the financing

statements after the Petition Date pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 549 (the "Transfers"). The

Trustee is hereby entitled to recover, and preserve for the benefit of the Debtors'

chapter 11 estates, the avoided Transfers, or their value, from the Defendants

pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 550(a) and 551.

(iii) On Count III of the Complaint, judgment enters in favor of the Trustee avoiding the

Transfers as violations of the automatic stay set forth in 11 U.S.C. § 362.

4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to enter any further orders necessary for the

enforcement of this Judgment.
