## ALEX E. GUZMAN'S PRO SE OBJECTION TO DEBTORS' SIXTY-FIFTH NOTICE OF CLAIM DISALLOWANCE

- 1. Debtors filed their Sixty-Fifth Notice of Claim Disallowance providing that the Participants did not file Claim Responses to the Notices of Proposed Resolution of Claim within 30 days as required by the terms of the Order and providing 21 days of the date of the Notice for Claim Participants to file a Response disputing the Proposed Claim disallowance and demonstrating good cause for failure to timely respond to the Notice of Proposed Resolution of Claim. - 3. The address on the envelope was correct and Guzman has not failed to receive or review his mail since November 2018. (See Exhibit B, Envelope)
- 4. It is impossible that the Debtors mailed this Notice to Guzman any earlier than February 2019.
- 5. It is impossible for Guzman to have responded to this Notice without it having been sent to him.
  - 6. Additionally, Guzman did respond to the December 26, 2017 Order.

Wherefore, Pro Se Participant Alex E. Guzman requests that this Court reject Debtors' Motion to Disallow the Claim and permit him the opportunity to present his Response to the Claim Disallowance.
