ORDER ON OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO GENERAL UNSECURED CLAIMS
(FIRST THROUGH SIXTEENTH)

A hearing was held on the 28th day of July, 2020, to consider the First through Sixteenth Omnibus Objection to General Unsecured Claims [docket nos. 3253-3268] (the “Objections”) filed by Stephen B. Darr, the Chapter 11 trustee (the “Trustee”)¹ of the bankruptcy estates (“Estates”) of TelexFree LLC, TelexFree, Inc., and TelexFree Financial, Inc. (collectively, “TelexFree”). All parties-in-interest were provided notice of the Objections and an opportunity to submit a response and to appear at the hearing by telephone. Based upon the Objections, the responses, and the argument and evidence provided at the hearing, and for due cause shown, the Court orders as follows with respect to the Objections.

1. Claim No. 689 filed by Heinrich J. Van Eer (identified in the 8th Omnibus Objection to General Unsecured Claims) shall be conditionally allowed in the amount of \$5,993.00.

2. Claim Nos. 2253 and 2255 filed by Sheila Rivera Olmeda (identified in the 14th Omnibus Objection to General Unsecured Claims) shall be continued generally.

¹ The Trustee is now serving as the Liquidating Trustee of the Reorganized Debtors pursuant to the terms of the First Amended Liquidating Plan of Reorganization confirmed by the Court on July 9, 2020.



3. All other objections by the Trustee to claims as set forth in the Objections are sustained and such claims are hereby disallowed.
