Order on the Trustee's Twenty-Sixth Motion to Disallow Net Winner Claims

On June 30, 2020, the Court continued generally the trustee's twenty-sixth motion to disallow net winner claims (ECF No. 2009) as to Claim No. 26841 of Jose Roberto Mejia Ramos, to allow the trustee to file an affidavit and to allow the claimant an opportunity to respond further. *See* Orders, ECF Nos. 3406, 3420. Having considered the trustee's motion, the claimant's response (ECF No. 2386), the affidavit of Timothy Martin filed in support of the trustee's motion (ECF No. 3495), which included as an exhibit the responses and supporting documentation submitted to the trustee by the claimant, and the trustee's status report (ECF No. 3583) confirming that the claimant has submitted nothing further, the Court hereby orders as follows.

1. The trustee's motion is allowed with respect to Claim No. 26841 of Jose Roberto Mejia Ramos, and the claim is disallowed in its entirety.
