**Order on the Trustee's Twenty-Sixth Motion to Disallow Net Winner Claims**

On June 30, 2020, the Court continued generally the trustee's twenty-sixth motion to disallow net winner claims (ECF No. 2009) as to Claim No. 26841 of Jose Roberto Mejia Ramos, to allow the trustee to file an affidavit and to allow the claimant an opportunity to respond further.
