Order on the Trustee's Thirty-Third Motion to Disallow Net Winner Claims

On June 30, 2020, the Court continued generally the trustee's thirty-third motion to disallow net winner claims (ECF No. 2903) as to Claim No. 00858 of Jose Anibel Bello, to allow the trustee to file an affidavit and to allow the claimant an opportunity to respond further.
