JUDGMENT

Upon consideration of the *Plaintiff's Uncontested Motion for Entry of Judgment against Defendant* (the "Motion"), and due cause appearing to me therefore, and due notice of the Motion having been provided, it is hereby ORDERED and ADJUDGED as follows:

13. The Motion is granted.

14. Final Judgment shall be and hereby is entered on this date in favor of Plaintiff Stephen Darr, the Liquidating Trustee of TelexFree, against the Defendant Drucila Wanzeler as follows:

(ix) On Count VIII, in favor of the Trustee against Drucila Wanzeler avoiding the transfers made by TelexFree to Drucila Wanzeler within two years of the petition




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date in the amount of \$15,678.00 as fraudulent transfers, and preserving such transfers for the benefit of the Debtors' estates, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §548, 550, and 551;

- (x) Judgment in favor of the Plaintiff Trustee against Defendant Drucila Wanzeler in the principal amount of \$15,678.00 plus interest from the date hereunder at the federal judgment rate until the Judgment has been satisfied.

15. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to enter any further orders necessary for the enforcement of this Judgment.
