ORDER MODIFYING THE DISCHARGE ORDER

Upon the joint request of counsel for reorganized debtor Car Outlet AC LLC in the above-captioned chapter 11 case (the "Reorganized Debtor") and counsel for plaintiff Kavonta Leaks (the "Claimant"), it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Claimant's motion to lift the automatic stay filed on January 20, 2020 in the cases jointly administered at Case No. 19-03734[Docket No. 710] (the "Motion") is treated as a motion to modify the injunction in Order Confirming the Second Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization for Total Finance Investment Inc. and Its Debtor Affiliates [Docket No. 501] (the "Discharge Order").

2. The injunction in the Discharge Order is modified with respect to the action pending in the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, Case No. 2017 L 11946 (the "Leaks Action"), for the exclusive purpose of permitting the Claimant to proceed against the Reorganized Debtor as a nominal defendant only, so that the Claimant may establish liability against the Reorganized Debtor for the sole purpose of recovering from either (a) any non-Reorganized Debtor defendants, (b) any proceeds of available insurance policies issued in the name or for the benefit of the Reorganized Debtor (collectively, the "Debtor Policies"), or (c) any third-party insurance policies that may apply (together with the Debtor Policies, the "Permitted Policies").
