**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXPEDITE HEARINGS
ON FIRST DAY MOTIONS**

Before the Court is Debtor’s Motion to Expedite Relief, seeking to be heard on its First Day Motions filed on March 1, 2017. The Court finds that it is appropriate to conduct hearings on an expedited basis. Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Debtor’s motion is GRANTED. Hearings on Debtor’s request for interim relief will be heard as follows:

First Preliminary Hearing:

FINAL HEARING:

All First Day Motions will be heard on **Thursday, March 23, 2017, at 9:00 a.m. in Courtroom #3, Second Floor, Quentin N. Burdick United States Courthouse, 655 First Avenue North, Fargo, North Dakota.** Deadline to file objections is: **March 22, 2017 at noon.** If the Court receives no objections, it may enter an order granting the relief requested and cancelling the hearing.

Your rights may be affected in this action. You should read these papers carefully and discuss the matters with your attorney if you have one. If you want the court to consider your views you should file a written response to the action, if one has not been

filed, and attend the hearing that has been scheduled. If you do not take these steps, the court may assume that you do not oppose the action and may enter an order approving the request made in these legal documents.
