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The Court, having reviewed the application ("<u>Application</u>") filed as Docket Number 483 by Jacob Nathan Rubin, MD, FAAC, the Patient Care Ombudsman ("<u>PCO</u>") appointed under Section 333 of the Bankruptcy Code in the above-referenced chapter 11 bankruptcy cases of the affected debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, "<u>Debtors</u>"), for Court approval of his employment of Levene, Neale, Bender, Yoo & Brill L.L.P. ("<u>LNBYB</u>") as bankruptcy counsel, and the Court having concluded that no party in interest has filed a timely objection to the Application and the United States Trustee has indicated its non-opposition to the Application by its execution of this Order below, and good cause appearing,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Application is approved upon the terms set forth in the Application.
- 2. LNBYB shall maintain all funds received by LNBYB from the Debtors pursuant to the Debtors' monthly payment procedure or otherwise in a segregated trust account pending the allowance of LNBYB's fees and expenses by the Court after notice and a hearing.
- In the event that the Court ultimately allows LNBYB fees and expenses in an
 amount that is less than the sums that LNBYB has been paid by the Debtors,
 LNBYB will repay the difference back to the Debtors.
- 4. Once the PCO's activity starts to slow down (i.e., when hospitals, etc. are sold), then LNBYB will be required to file fee applications every approximately 120 days.
- 5. The hearing on the Application, scheduled for November 7, 2018, at 10:00 a.m., is VACATED. Appearances at the hearing scheduled for November 7, 2018 are waived.
