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1 The Court, having reviewed the Stipulation Between U.S. Bank National Association and the 2 Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Extending Challenge Deadline (the "Third Stipulation"), filed as Docket No. 1536, entered between U.S. Bank National Association, as note trustee and 3 4 collateral agent under each of the 2015/2017 Indentures and related collateral documents defined in the Stipulation (collectively, the "Trustee"), on the one hand, and the Official Committee of Unsecured 5 6 Creditors of Verity Health System of California, Inc., et al. appointed in connection with the chapter 7 11 cases of the above-captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (the "Debtors"), on the other, and 8 good cause appearing,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

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The Third Stipulation is approved.

2. Section B of the Stipulation Between U.S. Bank National Association and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Extending Challenge Deadline [Docket No. 1048] (the "First Stipulation") is amended to delete the date "February 13, 2019" and replace the same with the date "March 15, 2019." Except for the foregoing, the First Stipulation continues in full force and effect in accordance with its original terms.

3. Pursuant to ¶5(e) of the *Final Order (I) Authorizing Postpetition Financing, (II) Authorizing Use of Cash Collateral, (III) Granting Liens and Providing Superpriority Administrative Expense Status, (IV) Granting Adequate Protection, (V) Modifying Automatic Stay, and (VI) Granting Related Relief* (the "Final Financing Order") [Doc. No. 409], the "'Challenge Deadline' for matters solely relating to the value of the Prepetition Collateral may be further extended to such time as may be agreed by stipulation among the *Debtors*, the Committee and the Prepetition Secured Creditors ...." (emphasis added). The Debtors are not a party to the Stipulation. Accordingly, this Order is without prejudice to the right of the Debtors to object to the extension of the Challenge Deadline approved herein. Any such objection shall be forever barred unless filed by no later than February 20, 2019.

IT IS SO ORDERED.

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
