PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Verity Health System of California, Inc. and the abovereferenced affiliated debtors, the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 bankruptcy cases (collectively, the "Debtors"), hereby supplement their Notice to Counterparties to Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases of the Debtors That May Be Assigned [Dkt. No. 1704] (the "Initial Cure Notice") filed in accordance with their (i) Motion For The Entry Of (I) An Order (1) Approving Form Of Asset Purchase Agreement For Stalking Horse Bidder And For Prospective Overbidders, (2) Approving Auction Sale Format, Bidding Procedures And Stalking Horse Bid Protections, (3) Approving Form Of Notice To Be Provided To Interested Parties, (4) Scheduling A Court Hearing To Consider Approval Of The Sale To The Highest Bidder, And (5) Approving Procedures Related To The Assumption Of Certain Executory Contracts And Unexpired Leases; And (II) An Order (A) Authorizing The Sale Of Property Free And Clear Of All Claims, Liens And Encumbrances [Dkt. No. 1279] (the "Motion"), and (ii) the order granting the Motion (the "Bidding Procedures Order") approving, among other things, the Bidding Procedures requested in the Motion, which Bidding Procedures Order governs (a) the bidding process for the sale of certain assets (the "Assets") of the Debtors, and (b) procedures for the assumption and assignment of certain of the Debtors' executory contracts and unexpired leases. [See Dkt. No. 1572.]

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Initial Cure Notice attached a list of executory contracts and unexpired leases subject to assumption (the "Executory Contracts Subject to Assumption") and set forth the amount, if any, which the Debtors asserted is owed to cure any defaults existing under the Executory Contract Subject to Assumption (the "Cure Amount"). Thereafter, the Debtors filed a notice of errata that provided that the cure amount related to "Saint Vincent IPA/Data Trust" in the Initial Cure Notice related to an ancillary services agreement and a risk sharing agreement was inadvertently listed as "\$0.00" instead of "TBD." [Dkt. No. 1793.] On March 18, 2019, the Debtors later filed a supplemental notice to the Initial Cure Notice (the "Supplemental Notice") [Dkt. No. 1836], (i) identifying additional Executory Contracts Subject to Assumption that were not originally included in the Initial Cure Notice, (ii) removing certain Executory Contracts Subject to Assumption from the Initial Cure Notice, and (iii) revising information concerning certain Executory Contracts Subject to Assumption listed in the Initial Cure Notice.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, since the filing of the Initial Cure Notice, the Debtors have been in negotiations with various counterparties regarding the Cure Amounts. The Debtors hereby file this Notice to reflect certain amended pre-petition Cure Amounts, which have been agreed to by the Debtors and each of the contract counterparties, as listed in the attached Exhibit "A." The contract counterparties and the Debtors reserve all rights relating to any postpetition amounts owing under the contracts listed in Exhibit "A."

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Debtors also hereby file this Notice to remove certain contracts from the Initial Cure Notice and Supplemental Notice that were incorrectly included therein, as set forth in the attached **Exhibit "B."**

Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion.

[&]quot;Executory Contracts Subject to Assumption" are those Contracts and Leases that the Debtors believe may be assumed and assigned as part of the orderly transfer of the Assets; however, the Successful Bidder may choose to exclude certain of the Debtors' Contracts or Leases from the list of Executory Contracts Subject to Assumption as part of their Qualifying Bid, causing such Contracts and Leases not to be assumed by the Debtors.
