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1. Levene, Neale, Bender, Yoo & Brill L.L.P. (the "Firm") hereby submits its Monthly Fee Application (the "Application") for Allowance and Payment of Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period March 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019 (the "Application Period"). In support of this Application, the Firm respectfully represents as follows:

- 2. The Firm is serving as counsel to Jacob Nathan Rubin, MD, FAAC, the Patient Care Ombudsman ("PCO") appointed in these chapter 11 bankruptcy cases. The PCO's application to employ the Firm was filed as Docket Number 483, and the Court order approving the PCO's employment of the Firm was entered as Docket Number 751.
- 3. The Firm incurred a total of \$4,193 in fees and \$106.10 in expenses during the Application Period for a total of \$4,299.10. The Firm billed 9.5 hours of time during the Application Period. These fees and expenses break down as follows:

- 4. In accordance with the Court order entered as Docket Number 826 (the "Fee Procedure Order"), the First seeks payment of 80% of its fees and 100% of its expenses incurred during the Application Period, which amounts to a total of \$3,460.50. In accordance with the terms of the Fee Procedure Order for the Firm, the Firm will hold this payment in a trust account until such time as the Court awards fees and expenses to the Firm in accordance with a fee application filed by the Firm.
 - 5. For the post-petition period, the Firm has been paid to date as follows:
 - October 2018: \$40,843.15 (for 100% of fees and expenses).
 - November 2018:\$16,103.71 (for 100% of fees and expenses).
 - December 2018: \$13,422.44 (for 100% of fees and expenses).

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- January 2019: \$3,747.40 (for 80% of fees and 100% of expenses).
- February 2019: \$12,381.52 (for 80% of fees and 100% of expenses).
- 6. Through March 31, 2019, the Firm is owed as follows:
 - January 2019: \$868.10
 - February 2019: \$3,020.00²
 - March 2019: \$4,299.10
- 7. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is the name of each professional employed by the Firm who performed services in connection with these chapter 11 bankruptcy cases during the Application Period and the hourly rate for each such professional. Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" are the detailed time and expense statements for the Application Period.
- 8. The Firm has served a copy of this Application by first class mail, postage prepaid, on April 24, 2019, on the Office of the United States Trustee, the above-captioned chapter 11 debtors (the "Debtors"), counsel to the Debtors, counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors and all parties who have requested special notice (collectively, the "Notice Parties").
- 9. Pursuant to the Fee Procedures Order, the Debtors are authorized to make the payment requested herein to the Firm without a further hearing or order of this Court unless an objection to this Application is filed with the Court and served upon the Notice Parties within ten (10) calendar days after the date of mailing of this Application (i.e., by May 4, 2019). If such an objection is timely filed, the Debtors are authorized to pay 80% of the uncontested fees and 100% of the uncontested expenses incurred by the Firm during the Application Period without further order of the Court. If no objection is timely filed, the Debtors are authorized to pay 80% of all fees requested and 100% of all expenses in this Application without further order of the Court.

10. The interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this Application 1 is not final. Upon the conclusion of these chapter 11 bankruptcy cases, the Firm will seek Court 2 approval of all fees and expenses incurred by the Firm during the entire term covering the Firm's 3 4 representation of the PCO.
