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At the above-captioned date and time, the Court conducted a hearing on the *Motion to Compel Compliance with Order Approving Procedures Related to the Assumption of Certain Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases* [Doc. No. 2563] (the "Motion"). Appearances were as stated on the record. For the reasons set forth in the Court's tentative ruling [Doc. No. 2694], which the Court adopts as its final ruling and which is incorporated herein by reference, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1) The Motion is GRANTED.
- 2) By no later than **July 17, 2019, at 5:00 p.m.**, the Debtors shall provide to UnitedHealthcare Insurance Company an irrevocable designation as to whether the Debtors will seek to assume and assign the United Provider Agreements (as defined in the Motion) to Strategic Global Management ("SGM").
- 3) By no later than **July 17, 2019, at 5:00 p.m.**, the Debtors shall provide to Cigna Healthcare of California, Inc., Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company, and Life Insurance Company of North America (collectively, the "Cigna Entities") an irrevocable designation as to whether the Debtors will seek to assume and assign the Cigna Provider Agreements (as defined in the Cigna Entities' joinder to the Motion, Doc. No. 2577) to SGM.
- 4) This order shall take effect immediately upon entry.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
