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The Court, having reviewed the *Stipulation to Dismiss Adversary Proceeding with Prejudice* (the "<u>Stipulation</u>"), ¹ filed as Docket No. 34, entered into by and between Defendants Verity Health System of California, Inc., Seton Medical Center, St. Vincent Medical Center, St. Vincent Dialysis Center, Inc., St. Francis Medical Center, Verity Holdings, LLC and DePaul Ventures, LLC (collectively, the "<u>Institutional Defendants</u>"), Defendants Richard Adcock and Steven Sharrer (the "<u>Individual Defendants</u>," and referred to with the Institutional Defendants as the ("<u>Defendants</u>" and individually as "<u>Defendant</u>"), and Plaintiff California Nurses Association ("<u>Plaintiff</u>" or "<u>CNA</u>," and referred collectively with the Defendants as the "<u>Parties</u>"), and good cause appearing therefor,

HEREBY ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Stipulation is APPROVED in its entirety.
- 2. The Adversary Proceeding shall be dismissed with prejudice, pursuant to the Settlement Agreement and Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (as made applicable to this Adversary Proceeding, pursuant to Rule 7041 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure).
