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The Court having reviewed and considered the Notice Of Motion And Motion For Relief From Stay And Plan Injunctions, the Motion For Relief From Stay And Plan Injunctions and the Declaration Of Daniel L. Varon [Docket Nos. 6795-1, 6795-2 and 6795-3] (collectively, the "Motion") filed on behalf of Cindy Campbell; the Limited Opposition To Third Party Plaintiff Cindy Campbell's Motion For Relief From The Automatic Stay And Plan Injunctions [Docket No. 6803], filed on behalf of the post-effective date Debtor, St. Francis Medical Center ("St. Francis"); and, the Stipulation Resolving Cindy Campbell's Motion For Relief From The Stay, [Docket No. 6806] entered into by and between Cindy Campbell and St. Francis; and, good cause appearing therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The Stipulation is approved.
- 2. Cindy Campbell has relief from the automatic stay to proceed against the Daughters of Charity and to seek recovery from the Daughters of Charity's insurance policies, if any; and
- 3. Cindy Campbell's rights, if any, to pursue insurance issued in favor of St. Francis, and all defenses that may be asserted by St. Francis including, but not limited to, the assertion that no applicable insurance exists and that St. Francis has no liability for events that occurred when the Daughters of Charity operated the hospital that was subsequently operated by St. Francis, are preserved for future resolution, if ever necessary.
