**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EMERGENCY HEARING
DEBTORS' MOTION FOR AN ORDER (I) SHORTENING THE
BAR DATE FOR FILING PROOFS OF CLAIM, (II) ESTABLISHING
RAMIFICATIONS FOR FAILURE TO TIMELY FILE CLAIMS,
(III) APPROVING NOTICE OF SHORTENED BAR DATE,
AND (IV) APPROVING THE MAILING OF NOTICES**

The Court has considered the *Motion for Emergency Hearing on Debtors' Motion for an Order (I) Shortening the Bar Date for Filing Proofs of Claim, (II) Establishing Ramifications for*

Failure to Timely File Claims, (III) Approving Notice of Shortened Bar Date, and (IV) Approving the Mailing of Notices (the “Motion to Expedite”),² filed by Vista Proppants and Logistics, LLC, *et al.* (collectively, the “Debtors”). The Court finds that good and sufficient cause exists to grant the relief requested in the Motion to Expedite.

Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion to Expedite is hereby GRANTED.
2. The hearing on the Bar Date Motion shall be set for **Friday, July 24, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. Central Time.**
3. Any objections or responses to the Bar Date Motion shall be filed on or before **July 23, 2020, at 5:00 p.m. Central Time.**
4. The Debtors are responsible for filing and serving a Notice of Emergency Hearing.
