Definitions and Instructions

- 1. The term "document" means any written, electronic or graphic means by which information is retained, saved, stored, preserved, viewed, transmitted or reported.
- 2. The term "communication" means the imparting or exchange of information between persons or systems by any means of transmission, including without limitation by voice, telephone, text, email, facsimile, wire, Bluetooth or WiFi transmission, or other writing.
- 3. The term "Guaranty Association" refers to the Alabama Workmen's Compensation Self-Insurers Guaranty Association, and all of the Association's agents, managers, employees, contractors, and others acting on the Association's behalf or at its direction.
- 4. The term "GRC" refers to General Reinsurance Corporation, and all of its agents, managers, employees, affiliates, contractors, and others acting on its behalf or at its direction.
- 5. The term "person" includes natural persons, corporations, partnerships, limited liability companies, ventures, and all other entities or forms of organization or association, and their officers, employees and agents.
- 6. The term "Walter Energy" refers to Walter Energy, Inc., and for all times, all of its parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, shareholders, directors, officers, employees, agents, attorneys, accountants, contractors, and others acting on its behalf or at its direction, including without limitation Jim Walter Resources, Inc. and each of the Debtors listed in footnote 1 above.

TRUSTEE'S REQUESTS FOR PRODUCTION

- 1. Produce all documents sufficient to show the calculations of any payments made from October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 to the Guaranty Association or the Trustee of Walter Energy regarding claims by Walter Energy or any of its affiliates.
- 2. Produce all documents related to any denials of claims made by the Guaranty Association or the Trustee of Walter Energy regarding claims by Walter Energy or any of its affiliates from October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020.
- 3. Produce all non-privileged communications relating to the calculations of any payments made from October 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 to the Guaranty Association or the Trustee of Walter Energy regarding claims by Walter Energy or any of its affiliates.
