OF MATTERS SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 30, 2018**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT:

1. The matters set forth below, previously scheduled to be heard before the Honorable Michael E. Wiles, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Southern District of New York, One Bowling Green, New York, New York 10004 (the “**Bankruptcy Court**”) on October 30, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. (Eastern Time) (the “**October Omnibus Hearing**”), are hereby adjourned with the consent of the movants and will be heard on **November 13, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. (Eastern Time)**, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard and include:

a. The *Omnibus Motion of Debtors Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 365(a) and 105(a) for Authority to Reject Certain Executory Contracts Related to the VC Summer and Vogtle Projects* [ECF No. 1664], only with respect to the contracts subject to the *Limited Objection of*

f. *Wind Down Co's Thirteenth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Redundant Claims)* [ECF No. 3782], regarding which a response was filed by Plumbers and Pipefitters Nation Pension Fund [ECF No. 3954], International Painters and Allied Trades Industry Pension Fund [ECF No. 3972], and United Association Union No. 322 Pension Plan [ECF No. 3971];

g. *Wind Down Co's Fourteenth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Redundant Claims)* [ECF No. 3783], only with respect to proofs of claim 3003 and 3040, regarding which a response was filed by American Equipment Co. [ECF No. 3959], and proofs of claim 1705 and 1734, regarding which a response was filed by Lucy Industrial [ECF No. 3957];

h. *Wind Down Co's Sixteenth Omnibus Objection to Claims (No Liability Claims)* [ECF No. 3794], only with respect to proof of claim 2805, regarding which a response was filed by United Association Union [ECF No. 3984], proof of claim 2773, regarding which a claim was filed by IUPAT Industry Pension Fund [ECF No. 3983], and to the response filed by Plumbers and Pipefitters Nation Pension Fund [ECF No. 3953];

i. *Wind Down Co's Twenty-First Omnibus Objection to Claims (Satisfied Claims – Assumed Contracts)* [ECF No. 3809], only with respect to the informal responses filed by BBC Chartering GmbH & Co. KG;

j. *Wind Down Co's Twenty-Second Omnibus Objection to Claims (Satisfied Claims – Assumed Contracts)* [ECF No. 3810], only with respect to the response filed by Mizuho American Leasing LLC and MHBK (USA) Leasing & Finance LLC [ECF No. 3958]; and

k. *Wind Down Co's Twenty-Third Omnibus Objection to Claims (No Liability Claims)* [ECF No. 3811], only with respect to the response filed by Arizona Public Services Co. [ECF No. 3960].

2. The *Motion of Transco Products, Inc. for Relief from the Automatic Stay to Permit Setoff of Mutual Obligations* [ECF No. 2426] is hereby adjourned with the consent of the movant and will be heard before the Bankruptcy Court on **January 22, 2019 at 11:00 a.m. (Eastern Time)**.

3. Wind Down Co hereby withdraws the following objections to claims:

a. *Wind Down Co's Eleventh Omnibus Objection to Claims (Redundant Claims)* [ECF No. 3780];

b. *Wind Down Co's Twelfth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Redundant Claims)* [ECF No. 3781]; and

c. *Wind Down Co's Twenty-First Omnibus Objection to Claims (Satisfied Claims – Assumed Contracts)* [ECF No. 3809], solely with respect to proof of claim 3582 filed by The Calvert Company.
