### The Parties' Relationship

A. On February 25, 2019 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), McLeodUSA and its affiliated debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, the "<u>Debtors</u>") each filed a voluntary petition under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York.
