A.M.G. Properties, Inc. This proof of claim (the "Claim") is being filed based on the estimated outstanding prepetition amounts due to AMG under the Leases. The estimated amounts due represent the reconciliation of 2022 taxes and insurance premiums that were not billed to IEH as of the Petition Date and remain outstanding.
