STATUS REPORT FOR JULY 23, 2013 STATUS CONFERENCE

Brian A. Bash, Trustee herein, submits the following summary of the status of the Trustee’s administration of the estate:¹

Recent Recoveries For the Estate

Since the last status conference in June 2013, the Trustee has recovered an additional \$248,370.68 for the estate, including a \$157,500 refund of a membership James Cochran held in a club, and \$42,748.15 from Duvera Billing Services. As of June 14, 2013, the balance in the money market account maintained by the Trustee for the benefit of the Debtor’s estate is \$6,233,473.79.

The Trustee’s Collection Efforts on Default Judgments

On April 23, 2013, the Trustee filed a motion asking this Court to issue a report and recommendation recommending entry of default judgment against Fair Holdings, Inc. and DC Investments, LLC in the total amount of \$141,116,304.88. That motion is pending before this Court.

On June 26, 2013, the Trustee filed a Creditor’s Bill action to attach the interests of Timothy Durham and James Cochran in an insurance policy with National Union.

The total amount of default judgments obtained by the Trustee is \$193,671,716.28, consisting of \$145,305,182.54 in Group A default judgments and \$48,366,533.74 in Group B default judgments. A spreadsheet identifying the adversary proceeding number, judgment debtor(s), default judgment date, amount and summary of collection strategy for each judgment is attached as **Exhibit A** to this status update.

The Trustee has targeted eleven judgments for domestication. The judgment debtors in these cases either appear to be collectible based on a preliminary examination or have very large judgments against them. The total amount of these judgments is \$168,990,496.26. The Trustee has domesticated five of these judgments in a total of nine counties or districts in the states of Indiana, South Carolina, California and Texas. The Trustee has begun the domestication process for five of these judgments in a total of nine counties or districts in Indiana, Texas and Florida. The Trustee is domesticating judgments in Mississippi and Georgia, now that the Trustee's retention of local counsel has been approved, and is evaluating collection options as to each defendant.

The Trustee is focusing his collection efforts on the judgment debtors with the eight largest outstanding judgments. The total amount of these judgments is \$184,127,060.53. The Trustee plans to pursue bank garnishments against the six largest judgment debtors.

The Trustee additionally issued a total of thirteen document subpoenas to all known banks for the six largest corporate judgment debtors to obtain documents to assist in evaluating and pursuing claims against persons or entities who received money from those judgment debtors, including subsequent transferee claims. The Trustee has received a response to each subpoena, and his forensic accountant has reviewed these documents. In light of recent judgments obtained, the Trustee will be issuing additional document subpoenas to other financial institutions. The Trustee anticipates filing more actions in the near future.

The Trustee conducted asset searches on all "high value" cases. The Trustee has deferred pursuit of ten judgments that have been classified as "low value" judgments. These judgments have been discussed in prior status reports.

The Trustee has obtained one default judgment against individuals who are believed to be British nationals. The total amount of this judgment is \$205,997.77. An evaluation of collectability issues is forthcoming.

Certain individuals have contacted the Trustee and expressed interest about purchasing certain assets belonging to Durham and/or the Estate. The Trustee is pursuing negotiations on the potential sale of those assets, assuming the ability to foreclose on those assets.

Subsequent Transferee Litigation

To date, the Trustee has filed two subsequent transferee adversary proceedings seeking a total of \$1,442,872.57. Additional subsequent transferee cases will be brought in the near future. The pending subsequent transferee litigation includes the following matters:

1. Litigation against Vitesse Corporation and Vitesse II, LLC (approximately \$1,275,872.57); and
2. Litigation against Old National Bank (approximately \$167,000.00).

Status of Litigation

The chart attached as **Exhibit B** includes a list of all pending litigation as of July 19, 2013, including those cases that have been settled or otherwise resolved by the Trustee, with information on the corresponding settlement amount or resolution. Additional descriptions are provided below.

Fortress. Written discovery has closed in the Fortress litigation and the parties have proceeded to depositions. The parties have taken 39 fact witness depositions in the case. The Trustee, Fortress and the Ohio Division of Securities have reached an agreement on the scope of a deposition of the Ohio Division of Securities, and that deposition will proceed in the near future. Fact discovery is almost complete, and the Trustee believes that all fact discovery will be timely completed.

On January 7, 2013, the Trustee filed a *Motion for Leave to File Second Amended Complaint* to, among other things, add a common law punitive damages claim. On June 17, 2013, the Court filed a Report and Recommendation granting the Trustee's motion for leave to file a Second Amended Complaint in this action. Fortress filed an objection to the Court's Report and Recommendation, and the Trustee filed a response in support of the Court's Report and Recommendation. On July 22, 2013, the District Court accepted the Report and Recommendation in part and rejected it in part, denying the Trustee's *Motion for Leave to File Second Amended Complaint*.

The Court held a status conference for the Fortress litigation on June 18, 2013. During the status conference, the Court established a schedule of the identification of experts and the exchange of expert reports. The parties identified their expert witnesses on July 12, 2013. Expert reports will be exchanged on August 16, 2013, with rebuttal expert reports due October 11, 2013.

During the status conference, the Court also established a summary judgment briefing schedule. Motions for summary judgment shall be filed by September 12, 2013, briefs in opposition to summary judgment shall be filed by October 11, 2013, and reply briefs shall be filed by October 25, 2013.

The Remaining “Group A” Cases:

The following are the other active and pending Group A cases:

1. Litigation against the former legal advisor for Fair Finance, Ronald Kaffen (approximately \$180,000);
2. Litigation against John Head, a former officer of the Debtor (approximately \$2.5 million in claims);
3. Litigation against Ricky Snow, a former officer of the Debtor (approximately \$1.7 million in claims).

In the litigation against Ronald Kaffen, the Trustee’s counsel has taken the depositions of both Ronald Kaffen and his law firm, both of which are defendants in the litigation, and the Trustee’s counsel has requested and obtained additional records from Mr. Kaffen relevant to Fair Finance and the claims at issue in the litigation. The remaining fact witness depositions in this litigation are being coordinated with the fact witness depositions in the Fortress matter in accordance with the Case Management Order entered in the Kaffen matter.

The discovery in the litigation against John Head and Ricky Snow is being coordinated with the discovery taking place in the Fortress litigation. Mr. Head is sitting for deposition in the Trustee’s case against him on July 20, 2013. On June 27, 2013, the Trustee and Mr. Head filed a joint motion for an extension of time to file joint stipulations of fact and separate statements of matters in dispute until July 31, 2013. In the litigation against Ricky Snow, the Trustee and counsel for Mr. Snow have agreed to settlement terms and documentation, which is pending signature by the incarcerated Mr. Snow and will be presented to the Court for approval.

“Group B” Cases

The one hundred and twenty-four (124) cases in the “Group B” category of cases include claims based on non-debtor transfers, loans or preferential transfers for which actions were filed after November 2011. These cases include the following:

1. **Fraudulent Transfer or Contract Claims:** This group of cases includes one hundred

and five (105) lawsuits. Of those lawsuits, thirteen (13) remain active and contested and an additional four (4) cases have been stayed, generally because of the defendant's bankruptcy. The Trustee has settled or otherwise resolved his claims in forty-five (45) lawsuits. In addition, a number of defendants in these lawsuits have defaulted, including all of the defendants in forty-three (43) lawsuits and some of the defendants in six (6) lawsuits. The Trustee has obtained default judgments in most of these cases.

2. **Section 547 Claims Against Investors:** The Trustee filed twelve (12) preference complaints against investors. All of these complaints have been settled or otherwise resolved.
3. **Section 547 Claims Against Non-Investors:** The Trustee filed seven (7) complaints against non-investors receiving preferential payments from the Debtor. All of these complaints have been settled or otherwise resolved.

The chart attached as **Exhibit B** includes a list of all of the Group B cases status as of July 19, 2013, including those cases that have been settled or otherwise resolved by the Trustee with information on the corresponding settlement amount or resolution. The Trustee is pursuing settlement of the remaining Group B cases and will continue to prepare those matters for trial, if necessary. In the *Etelco*, *Landeem*, and *Alternate Billing Corp.* cases, while a settlement was reached in principle, changed circumstances have required additional negotiations.

Other Litigation: The Trustee is pursuing recovery for the estate in several other lawsuits involving certain state-law claims, including loan claims and claims against certain insiders of the Debtor. This group of cases includes the only lawsuit filed by the Trustee outside of this district (the *National Lampoon* litigation filed in the United States District Court for the Central District of California, Western Division). These cases include the following:

1. **The *Laikin* litigation (approximately \$25 million).** As the Court is aware, the Trustee recently filed a *Motion for Sanctions Against Defendant Daniel Laikin* under seal. The *Motion* seeks entry of a default judgment against Mr. Laikin for discovery misconduct. In addition, the Trustee is continuing to review the more than 60 gigabytes of National Lampoon data (approximately equivalent to 1,500 bankers' boxes) that the Trustee discovered after this Court reopened discovery. The Court has scheduled the trial to begin on September 16, 2013, subject to a decision on the *Motion for Sanctions*.
2. **National Lampoon (approximately \$9 million).** As noted above under the *Laikin* litigation, the Trustee has received access to a significant volume of discovery material which was in the possession of National Lampoon. Discovery is ongoing. The Trustee and counsel for National Lampoon have been cooperating with respect to the additional discovery and also intend to explore alternatives for resolving the Trustee's claims. The District Court has set trial in this matter for June 3, 2014.

3. **The *McKibben* litigation against insiders of the Debtor and entities they controlled.** The Trustee, and Defendants Head and Laikin participated in mediation in the past month and efforts to settle the case are ongoing.

Trustee's Focus in the Upcoming Weeks

Continuing Litigation: The Trustee's counsel will continue to focus efforts on the litigation of the cases that have been filed by the Trustee to date.
