## REQUEST FOR EMERGENCY CONSIDERATION OF CERTAIN "FIRST DAY" MATTERS

On July 12, 2018, Neighbors Legacy Holdings, Inc. and certain of its affiliates (the "Debtors") each filed petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. Counsel for the debtors believes that these cases qualify as "Complex Chapter 11 Cases." The Debtors need emergency consideration of the following initial case matters:

- <u>X</u> Debtors' Emergency Application to Employ Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC as Claims Noticing and Solicitation Agent, Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date [Docket No. 4].
- <u>X</u> Debtors' Emergency Motion for an Order (I) Approving Adequate Assurance of Payment to Utility Companies, (II) Establishing Procedures to Resolve Objections, and (III) Prohibiting Utility Companies from Altering, Refusing, or Discontinuing Service [Docket No. 6].
- <u>X</u> Debtors' Emergency Motion for Interim and Final Orders Authorizing the Debtors to (i) Continue Operating their Cash Management System, (ii) Honor Certain Prepetition Obligations, (iii) Maintain Existing Business Forms, and (iv) Granting Related Relief [Docket No. 9].
- <u>X</u> Debtors' Emergency Motion for an Order Authorizing the Implementation of Procedures to Protect Confidential Patient Information [Docket No. 11]

- <u>X</u> Debtors' Emergency Motion to (I) Extend the Time to File Schedules and Statements of Financial Affairs, (II) Authorize the Debtors to File a Consolidated List of Their 50 Largest Unsecured Creditors, and (III) Waive the Requirement that Each Debtor File a List of Creditors [Docket No. 15].
