

1 The Court has considered the *Liquidating Trusts' Eighth Omnibus Motion for Order*
2 *Seeking (1) Reclassification and/or Reduction of Certain Claims Misclassified as Priority Claims*
3 *and (2) Disallowance or Reduction of Certain Claims Not Supported by the Debtors' Books and*
4 *Records* (Docket No. 2831) (the "Objection"), filed on February 28, 2014 by the PC Trusts, by and
5 through the Liquidating Trustee, seeking entry of an order disallowing and expunging certain
6 claims.²

7 The Court considered the Objection and all related papers and documents. No
8 timely written opposition was filed in response to the Objection.

9 The Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to sections 157 and 1334 of
10 Title 28 of the United States Code, and the Court finds the form, scope and timing of notice of the
11 Motion was adequate under the circumstances of these cases.³

12 Based upon the foregoing and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is
13 hereby:

14 **ORDERED THAT:**

15 1. The Objection is sustained with respect to the following claims (the
16 "Claims") listed on Exhibits A, B, and C of the Objection and identified on the Debtors' Claims
17 Dockets with the associated numbers:

- 18 (a) PCFC Claim No. 53 [Greater Bay Appraisal/Pathway Appraisal];
19 (b) PCHLI Claim No. 314 [M. Sally Riley];
20 (c) PCFC Claim No. 36 [Nicole Decker];
21 (d) PCHLI Claim No. 8 [Carmin F. D'Urso]; and
22 (e) PCFI Claim No. 10 [Carmin F. D'Urso].

23 2. The Claims are reclassified and/or reduced as set forth on Exhibit A (except
24 for PCHLI Claim No. 113 [Geraldine Dougherty Company]) and Exhibit B and disallowed or
25 reduced as set forth on Exhibit C. The holders of such Claims that are disallowed shall not be
