Lafferty, United States Bankruptcy Judge, to consider the *Motion to Allow Filing of Late Proof of Claim* (the "Motion"), filed concurrently herewith, by a claimant who is a sexual abuse claimant that holds a claim against the Debtor. 21 **of any objection.**
