**GLOBAL NOTES, METHODOLOGY, AND SPECIFIC DISCLOSURES
REGARDING SUPERIOR ENERGY SERVICES, INC.'S SCHEDULES OF

Introduction

Superior Energy Services, Inc. as debtor (the “**Debtor**”) in possession in the above-captioned chapter 11 cases (the “**Chapter 11 Cases**”), with the assistance of its advisors, has filed its Schedules of Assets and Liabilities (the “**Schedules**”) and Statements of Financial Affairs (the “**Statements**,” and together with the Schedules, the “**Schedules and Statements**”) with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “**Bankruptcy Court**”), pursuant to section 521 of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101–1532 (the “**Bankruptcy Code**”), Rule 1007 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “**Bankruptcy Rules**”), and Rule 1007-1 of the Local Rules of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas (the “**Local Rules**”).

These *Global Notes, Methodology, and Specific Disclosures Regarding Superior Energy Services Inc.’s Schedules of Assets and Liabilities and Statements of Financial Affairs* (the “**Global Notes**”) pertain to, are incorporated by reference in, and comprise an integral part of all of the Debtor’s Schedules and Statements. The Global Notes should be referred to, considered, and reviewed in connection with any review of the Schedules and Statements.

The Schedules and Statements do not purport to represent financial statements prepared in accordance with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in the United States (“**GAAP**”), nor are they intended to be fully reconciled with the financial statements of the Debtor. Additionally, the Schedules and Statements contain unaudited information that is subject to further review and potential adjustment.

The Debtor and its agents, attorneys, and financial advisors do not guarantee or warrant the accuracy or completeness of the data that is provided herein and shall not be liable for any loss or injury

Mr. Ballard has not (and could not have) personally verified the accuracy of each statement and representation contained in the Schedules and Statements, including statements and representations concerning amounts owed to creditors, classification of such amounts, and creditor addresses.

Global Notes and Overview of Methodology

1. **Reservation of Rights.** Reasonable efforts have been made to prepare and file complete and accurate Schedules and Statements; however, inadvertent errors or omissions may exist. The Debtor reserves all rights to (a) amend or supplement the Schedules and Statements from time to time, in all respects, as may be necessary or appropriate, including, without limitation, the right to amend the Schedules and Statements with respect to claim (“**Claim**”) description, designation, or Affiliate Debtor (as defined below) against which the Claim is asserted; (b) dispute or otherwise assert offsets or defenses to any Claim reflected in the Schedules and Statements as to amount, liability, priority, status or classification; (c) subsequently designate any Claim as “disputed,” “contingent,” or “unliquidated;” or object to the extent, validity, enforceability, priority or avoidability of any Claim (regardless of whether such Claim is designated in the Schedules and Statements as “disputed,” “contingent,” or “unliquidated”). Any failure to designate a Claim in the Schedules and Statements as “disputed,” “contingent,” or “unliquidated” does not constitute an admission by the Debtors that such Claim or amount is not “disputed,” “contingent,” or “unliquidated.” Listing a Claim does not constitute an admission of liability by the Debtor. Furthermore, nothing contained in the Schedules and Statements shall constitute a waiver of rights with respect to the Chapter 11 Cases, including issues involving Claims, substantive consolidation, defenses, equitable subordination, and/or causes of action arising under the provisions of chapter 5 of the Bankruptcy Code and any other relevant non-bankruptcy laws to recover assets or avoid transfers. Any specific reservation of rights contained elsewhere in these Global Notes does not limit in any respect the general reservation of rights contained in this paragraph.

2. **Description of Cases and “As Of” Information Date.** On December 7, 2020 (the “**Petition Date**”), the Debtor and its affiliate debtors in these Chapter 11 Cases (the “**Affiliate Debtors**,” and collectively with the Debtor, the “**Debtors**”) filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtors are operating their businesses and managing their properties as debtors in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. The Chapter 11 Cases are “prepackaged” cases commenced for the purpose of implementing a restructuring of the Debtors’ liabilities. As of the Petition Date, the Debtors have entered into that certain Amended & Restated Restructuring Support Agreement, dated as of December 4, 2020 (as amended,

modified, or supplemented, the “**Restructuring Support Agreement**”)² with holders of approximately 85% of the outstanding principal amount of the Debtors’ senior unsecured notes.

A plan of reorganization reflecting the terms of the Restructuring Support Agreement (as may be amended, modified, or supplemented, the “**Plan**”) was filed on the Petition Date. Among other things, the Plan contemplates that all general unsecured claims against the Affiliate Debtors will be paid in full or will otherwise be unimpaired, but that unsecured claims against the Debtor would receive treatment in accordance with the Plan and be ultimately discharged. As a result, the Debtor has filed these Schedules and Statements solely with respect to itself.

The asset and liability information provided herein represents the asset data of the Debtor as of November 30, 2020, and the liability data of the Debtor as of the Petition Date, except as otherwise noted.

3. **Net Book Value of Assets.** Unless otherwise indicated, the Debtor’s Schedules and Statements reflect net book values as of the Petition Date. Book values of assets prepared in accordance with GAAP generally do not reflect the current performance of the assets and may differ materially from the actual value and/or performance of the underlying assets.
4. **Recharacterization.** Notwithstanding the Debtor’s commercially reasonable efforts to properly characterize, classify, categorize, or designate certain Claims, assets, executory contracts, unexpired leases, and other items reported in the Schedules and Statements, the Debtor may nevertheless have improperly characterized, classified, categorized, designated, or omitted certain items due to the complexity and size of the Debtor’s businesses. Accordingly, the Debtor reserves all of its rights to re-characterize, reclassify, recategorize, redesignate, add, or delete items reported in the Schedules and Statements at a later time as is necessary or appropriate as additional information becomes available, including, without limitation, whether contracts or leases listed herein were deemed executory or unexpired as of the Petition Date and remain executory and unexpired postpetition. Disclosure of information in one or more Schedules, one or more Statements, or one or more exhibits or attachments to the Schedules or Statements, even if incorrectly placed, shall be deemed to be disclosed in the correct Schedules, Statements, exhibits, or attachments.
5. **Liabilities.** The Debtor has sought to allocate liabilities between the prepetition and postpetition periods based on the information and research conducted in connection with the preparation of the Schedules and Statements. As additional information becomes available and further research is conducted, the allocation of liabilities between the prepetition and postpetition periods may change. Accordingly, the Debtor reserves all of its rights to amend, supplement, or otherwise modify the Schedules and Statements as is necessary or appropriate.
6. **Excluded Assets and Liabilities.** The Debtor has excluded rejection damage Claims of counterparties to executory contracts and unexpired leases that may or may not be rejected, to the extent such damage Claims exist. In addition, certain immaterial assets and liabilities may have been excluded.
7. **Insiders.** For purposes of the Schedules and Statements, the Debtor defined “insiders” pursuant to section 101(31) of the Bankruptcy Code as: (a) directors; (b) officers; (c) persons in control of the Debtor; (d) relatives of the Debtor’s directors, officers or persons in control of the Debtor; and (e)

debtor/non-debtor affiliates of the foregoing. The officers presented have been limited to individuals who qualify as insiders under Section 16 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Persons listed as “insiders” have been included for informational purposes only and by including them in the Schedules, shall not constitute an admission that those persons are insiders for purposes of section 101(31) of the Bankruptcy Code. Moreover, the Debtor does not take any position with respect to: (a) such person’s influence over the control of the Debtor; (b) the management responsibilities or functions of such individual; (c) the decision making or corporate authority of such individual; or (d) whether the Debtor or such individual could successfully argue that he or she is not an “insider” under applicable law, including, without limitation, the federal securities laws, or with respect to any theories of liability or for any other purpose.

8. **Executory Contracts and Leases.** Although the Debtor made diligent attempts to attribute an executory contract or lease to its rightful parties, in certain instances, the Debtor may have inadvertently failed to do so due to the complexity and size of the Debtor’s businesses. Accordingly, the Debtor reserves all of its rights with respect to the named parties of any and all executory contracts and leases, including the right to amend Schedule G.
9. **Classifications.** Listing (a) a Claim on Schedule D as “secured,” (b) a Claim on Schedule E/F as “priority,” (c) a Claim on Schedule E/F as “unsecured,” or (d) a contract on Schedule G as “executory” or “unexpired,” does not constitute an admission by the Debtor of the legal rights of the claimant or a waiver of the Debtor’s rights to re-characterize or reclassify such Claims or contracts or to setoff of such Claims, as appropriate.
10. **Claims Description.** Schedules D and E/F permit the Debtor to designate a Claim as “disputed,” “contingent,” and/or “unliquidated.” Any failure to designate a Claim on the Debtor’s Schedules and Statements as “disputed,” “contingent,” or “unliquidated” does not constitute an admission by the Debtor that such amount is not “disputed,” “contingent,” or “unliquidated,” or that such Claim is not subject to objection. The Debtor reserves all its rights to dispute, or assert offsets or defenses to, any Claim reflected on its respective Schedules and Statements on any grounds, including, without limitation, amount, liability, validity, priority or classification. Additionally, the Debtor expressly reserves all of its rights to subsequently designate such Claims as “disputed,” “contingent” or “unliquidated.” Moreover, listing a Claim does not constitute an admission of liability by the Debtor and the Debtor reserved the right to amend the Schedules and Statements accordingly.
11. **Causes of Action.** Despite its commercially reasonable efforts to identify all known assets, the Debtor may not have listed all of its causes of action or potential causes of action against third-parties as assets in the Schedules and Statements, including, without limitation, causes of actions arising under the provisions of chapter 5 of the Bankruptcy Code and any other relevant non-bankruptcy laws to recover assets or avoid transfers. The Debtor reserves all of its rights with respect to any cause of action (including avoidance actions), controversy, right of setoff, cross claim, counterclaim, or recoupment and any claim on contracts or for breaches of duties imposed by law or in equity, demand, right, action, lien, indemnity, guaranty, suit, obligation, liability, damage, judgment, account, defense, power, privilege, license, and franchise of any kind or character whatsoever, known, unknown, fixed or contingent, matured or unmatured, suspected or unsuspected, liquidated or unliquidated, disputed or undisputed, secured or unsecured, assertable directly or derivatively, whether arising before, on, or after the Petition Date, in contract or in tort, in law or in equity, or pursuant to any other theory of law (collectively, “**Causes of Action**”) they may have, and neither these Global Notes nor the Schedules and Statements shall be deemed a waiver of any claims or Causes of Action or in any way prejudice or impair the assertion of such claims or Causes of Action.

12. **Insurance.** The insurance policies listed in Part 11, question 73 are for the benefit of the Debtor and all of its affiliated entities.
13. **Summary of Significant Reporting Policies.** The following is a summary of significant reporting policies:
 - **Undetermined Amounts.** The description of an amount as “undetermined” is not intended to reflect upon the materiality of such amount.
 - **Totals.** All totals that are included in the Schedules and Statements represent totals of all known amounts. To the extent there are undetermined amounts, the actual total may be different than the listed total.
14. **Currency.** Unless otherwise indicated, all amounts are reflected in U.S. dollars.
15. **Global Notes Control.** In the event that the Schedules and Statements differ from these Global Notes, the Global Notes shall control.

Specific Disclosures with Respect to the Debtor’s Schedules

Schedules Summary. Except as otherwise noted, the asset information provided herein represents the Debtor’s data as November 30, 2020, and the liability information provided herein represents the Debtor’s data as of the Petition Date.

For financial reporting purposes, the Debtor and certain of their debtor and non-debtor affiliates ordinarily prepare consolidated financial statements. Unlike the consolidated financial statements, the Schedules reflect the assets and liabilities of the Debtor on a nonconsolidated basis, except where otherwise indicated. Accordingly, the totals listed in the Schedules will likely differ, at times materially, from the consolidated financial reports prepared by the Debtor and its debtor and non-debtor affiliates for financial reporting purposes or otherwise.

The Schedules do not purport to represent financial statements prepared in accordance with GAAP, nor are they intended to be fully reconciled with the financial statements of the Debtor. Additionally, the Schedules contain unaudited information that is subject to further review and potential adjustment, and reflect the Debtor’s reasonable best efforts to report its assets and liabilities on an unconsolidated basis. Moreover, given, among other things, the uncertainty surrounding the collection and ownership of certain assets and the valuation and nature of certain liabilities, to the extent that the Debtor shows more assets than liabilities, this is not an admission that the Debtor was solvent as of the Petition Date or at any time before the Petition Date. Likewise, to the extent the Debtor shows more liabilities than assets, this is not an admission that the Debtor was insolvent as of the Petition Date or at any time before the Petition Date.

Schedule A/B.3. Balances related to bank accounts are as of December 4, 2020.

Schedule A/B.15. Equity interests in subsidiaries and affiliates primarily arise from member interests. For purposes of these Schedules, the Debtor has listed an undetermined value for the equity interests.

Schedule D. Except as otherwise agreed pursuant to a stipulation, agreed order, or general order entered by the Bankruptcy Court), the Debtor reserves its rights to dispute or challenge the extent, validity, priority, perfection, or immunity from avoidance of any lien purported to be granted or perfected in any specific asset to a creditor listed on Schedule D of the Debtor. Moreover, subject to the exception set forth above, although the Debtor may have scheduled claims of various creditors as secured claims, the Debtor reserves

all rights to dispute or challenge the secured nature of any such creditor's claim or the characterization of the structure of any such transaction or any document or instrument (including, without limitation, any inter-creditor or intercompany agreement) related to such creditor's claim. The descriptions provided on Schedule D are intended only as a summary. Reference to the applicable loan agreements and related documents is necessary for a complete description of the collateral and the nature, extent, perfection and priority of any liens. Nothing in the Global Notes or the Schedules and Statements shall be deemed a modification or interpretation of the terms of such agreements.

In response to "Describe debtor's property that is subject to lien", any description of the creditor's liens or their priority herein is qualified in its entirety by reference to the operative documents, agreements, schedules, any amendments and exhibits to the preceding and any documents evidencing perfection of such lien. The Debtor is taking no position on the extent or priority of a particular creditor's lien in this document.

The Debtor has not included parties that may believe their Claims are secured through setoff rights.

Further, unless otherwise specified on Schedule G, it is the Debtor's intent that each executory contract or unexpired lease listed thereon shall include all exhibits, schedules, riders, modifications, declarations, amendments, supplements, attachments, restatements, or other agreements made directly or indirectly by any agreement, instrument, or other document that in any manner affects such executory contract or unexpired lease, without respect to whether such agreement, instrument, or other document is listed thereon. In some cases, the same supplier or provider appears multiple times on Schedule G. This multiple listing is intended to reflect distinct agreements between the Debtor and such supplier or provider.
