ORDER (I) EXTENDING TIME TO FILE
(A) THE CREDITOR MATRIX, AND (B) SCHEDULES
OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES, SCHEDULES OF EXECUTORY
CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES, AND STATEMENTS
OF FINANCIAL AFFAIRS AND (II) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF

Upon the motion (the "Motion")² of the above-captioned debtor and debtor in possession (the "Debtor") for entry of an order (this "Order"): (i) extending the deadline to file the Creditor Matrix and the Schedules and Statements, and (ii) granting related relief, all as more fully set forth in the Motion; and this Court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; and this Court having found this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and that this Court may enter a final order consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution; and this Court having found that venue of this proceeding and the Motion in this district is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and this Court having found that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor's estate, its creditors, and other parties in interest; and this Court having found that the Debtor's notice of the Motion and opportunity for a hearing on the Motion were appropriate under the circumstances and no other notice need be provided; and this Court having reviewed the Motion and having heard the statements in support of the relief

requested therein at a hearing before this Court (the "<u>Hearing</u>"); and this Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion and at the Hearing establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and upon all of the proceedings had before this Court; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The time within which the Debtor must file the Creditor Matrix is extended for an additional 14 days from the Petition Date, through and including February 27, 2023, without prejudice to the Debtor's right to further extend the date by which the Debtor is required to file the Creditor Matrix by filing an agreed stipulation with the Court.
- 2. The time within which the Debtor must file the Schedules and Statements is extended for an additional 31 days, for a total of 45 days after the Petition Date, through and including March 30, 2023, without prejudice to the Debtors' right to further extend the date by which the Debtor is required to file the Schedules and Statements by filing an agreed stipulation with the Court.
- 3. All time periods set forth in this Order shall be calculated in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a).
- 4. Notice of the Motion as provided therein shall be deemed good and sufficient notice of such Motion and the requirements of the Bankruptcy Rules and the Bankruptcy Local Rules are satisfied by such notice.
- 5. Notwithstanding any Bankruptcy Rule to the contrary, the terms and conditions of this Order are immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.
- 6. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted in this Order in accordance with the Motion.

7. This Court retains exclusive jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
