PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the Bankruptcy Court has set a hearing as described below (the “July 6 Hearing”) to consider the request to further extend the Temporary Restraining Order or for other appropriate relief as set forth in the Complaint and the Motion, including the entry of a preliminary injunction for a limited period of time. See Temporary Restraining Order at ¶ 3. The July 6 Hearing is scheduled for **Monday, July 6, 2020, at 10:30 a.m.** (prevailing Eastern Time), or as soon thereafter as can be heard, before the Honorable Judge J. Craig Whitley at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of North Carolina, Charlotte Division, Courtroom C1-4, 401 West Trade Street, Charlotte, North Carolina 28202. Please note that the July 6 Hearing will be held via video and telephonically through Zoomgov.com, as described in further detail below. No parties will be permitted to appear at the hearing in person.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that your rights may be affected. You should read the Complaint, the Motion and the Temporary Restraining Order carefully and discuss them with your attorney. If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT you need not appear at the July 6 Hearing if you do not object to the relief requested in the Complaint or the Motion.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT the July 6 Hearing may be continued or adjourned from time to time without further notice other than an announcement of the adjourned date or dates at the July 6 Hearing or at a later hearing.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT if you would like copies of the Motion, the Complaint, the Temporary Restraining Order or the Case Management Order, you may access such documents: (A) for a nominal fee at the website of the Bankruptcy Court, www.ncwb.uscourts.gov, under the Debtor’s name and the Adversary Proceeding case number or Chapter 11 Case number, as listed above; (B) through the website maintained by the Debtors’ claims, noticing, and ballot agent at <http://www.kccllc.net/aldrich> free of charge; or (C) by written request directed to the undersigned counsel.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the July 6 Hearing will be held via video conference and telephone conference using ZoomGov.com.
