1 The Court, having read and considered the *Application Of Abbott Laboratories*
2 *Inc. For Allowance Of Administrative Expense Priority Claims Pursuant To 11*
3 *U.S.C. § 503* [Docket No. 1522] (the “Request”) and accompanying notice [Docket
4 No. 1525] filed by Abbott Laboratories Inc., for and on behalf of itself and its
5 divisions, including Abbott Nutrition, Abbott Vascular, and St. Jude Medical
6 (collectively “Abbott”), the *Debtors’ Response To Abbott Laboratories Inc.’s*
7 *Request For Allowance And Payment Of Administrative Expense Claim* [Docket No.
8 1671] (the “Response”), and this Agreed Order evidencing the parties’ agreement;
9 deeming itself fully advised; finding and concluding that notice hereof was given in
10 accordance with applicable Local Rules; and finding and concluding that good cause
11 has been otherwise shown for the relief requested, now, therefore, it is hereby
12 ORDERED as follows:

13 1. The Motion is GRANTED;

14 2. Abbott is hereby allowed, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 503(b)(3), an
15 administrative expense claim in the amount of \$68,047.04 for amounts owed to
16 Abbott by the Debtors in connection with for goods that were delivered within twenty
17 (20) days before the Debtors filed their voluntary petitions for relief under chapter
18 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on May 6, 2020;

19 3. Abbott’s allowed administrative expense claim shall have the priority
20 afforded by 11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(2); and
