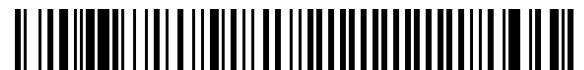


Motion having been adequate and appropriate under the circumstances; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing; it is hereby:
