**ORDER (I) DIRECTING JOINT ADMINISTRATION OF
CHAPTER 11 CASES AND (II) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF**

Upon consideration of the Motion¹ of the above-captioned Debtors² for entry of an order, pursuant to Section 105(a) of Title 11 of the U.S. Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”) and Rule 1015 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (the “Bankruptcy Rules”), authorizing the joint administration of the Debtors’ cases under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code; and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction to consider the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that venue of these cases and the Motion in this district is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C.

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§§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing that this matter is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and it appearing that adequate and proper notice of the Motion has been given and that no other or further notice need be given; and a hearing having been held to consider the relief requested in the Motion; and upon the record of the hearing and all of the proceedings had before the Court; and the Court having found and determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, their creditors, and all other parties in interest, and will not otherwise prejudice the Debtors' creditors; and the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion having established just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and good and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is granted as set forth herein.
2. The above-captioned chapter 11 cases are consolidated for procedural purposes only and shall be jointly administered by the Court under Case No. 23-02871-TOM.
3. The caption of the jointly administered cases should read as follows:

6. The Debtors shall maintain, and the Clerk of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Alabama shall keep, one consolidated docket, and one consolidated service list for these chapter 11 cases.

7. The Debtors are authorized to prepare and file their monthly operating reports on a consolidated basis.

8. Nothing contained in the Motion or this Order shall be deemed or construed as directing or otherwise effecting a substantive consolidation of these chapter 11 cases and this Order shall be without prejudice to the rights of Debtors to seek entry of an Order substantively consolidating their respective cases.

9. Notice of the Motion as provided therein shall be deemed good and sufficient notice of such Motion and the requirements of Bankruptcy Rule 6004(a) are satisfied by such notice.

10. The terms and conditions of this Order are immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

11. The Debtors are authorized to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted in this Order in accordance with the Motion.

12. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to the implementation, interpretation, and enforcement of this Order.
