THIRD OMNIBUS NOTICE OF SATISFACTION OF CLAIMS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT:

On June 1, 2020 (the “Petition Date”), Templar Energy LLC and its affiliated debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the “Debtors”) filed petitions for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101–1532, in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Court”).

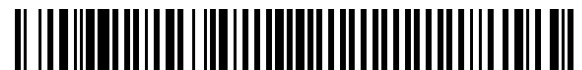
On July 17, 2020, the Court confirmed the *Second Amended Joint Prepackaged Plan of Liquidation of Templar Energy LLC and its Debtor Affiliates Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* (the “Plan”).² See Docket No. 217. The Plan went effective on August 3, 2020.

The Plan Administrator has reviewed the Debtors’ books and records and has determined that the claims listed on **Exhibit A** attached hereto (collectively, the “Satisfied Claims”) have been satisfied in full after the Petition Date and no further distributions are required on account of such satisfied amounts. Accordingly, the Plan Administrator intends to have the Debtor’s Court-appointed claims and noticing agent, Kurtzman Carson Consultants LLC (“KCC”), designate on the official claims register that the Satisfied Claims have been previously satisfied as set forth on **Exhibit A**.

Out of an abundance of caution, however, the Plan Administrator is serving this notice on all parties holding the Satisfied Claims and providing such parties with an opportunity to object to the Plan Administrator’s position that such amounts have been satisfied, in full or in part as applicable. To the extent that any party disputes the determination that a Satisfied Claim has been satisfied as set forth on **Exhibit A**, such party shall file a written response (an “Objection”) with the Clerk of the Court, 824 North Market Street, 3rd Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, and serve such Objection on the undersigned counsel to the Plan Administrator on or before **March 9, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. ET** (the “Objection Deadline”).

The chapter 11 cases of the following affiliates of the Debtor were closed effective as of July 31, 2020: Templar Energy LLC (4719), TE Holdings, LLC (3115), TE Holdings II, LLC (N/A), Templar Operating LLC (0810), Templar Midstream LLC (3275), and TE Holdings Management LLC (7467). ² Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Plan.



To the extent an Objection is timely filed and served in accordance with the procedures set forth in the preceding paragraph, the Plan Administrator shall attempt to consensually resolve the Objection with the objecting party. In the event the parties are unable to reach a consensual resolution, a hearing will be held on the matter on a date to be separately noticed.

If no Objections are received prior to the Objection Deadline, KCC shall update the claims register as set forth herein without further order of the Court.

The Plan Administrator reserves any and all rights to amend, supplement, or otherwise modify the list of claims identified on **Exhibit A** and to file additional notices of this nature with respect to any claim in the Chapter 11 Cases and file objections to any proof of claim filed in the Chapter 11 Cases. The Plan Administrator also reserves any and all rights, claims, and defenses with respect to the claims identified on **Exhibit A**, and nothing included or omitted herein shall impair, prejudice, or otherwise affect any such rights, claims, and defenses.
