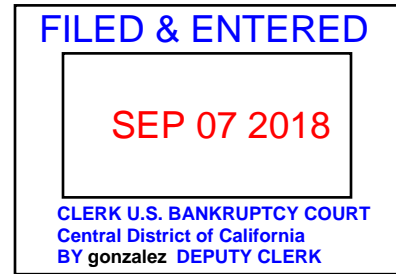

**ORDER (A) APPROVING THE DEBTORS FILING A CONSOLIDATED LIST OF FIFTY LARGEST GENERAL UNSECURED CREDITORS FOR ALL CASES; (B) APPROVING THE DEBTORS FILING A CONSOLIDATED MASTER MAILING MATRIX FOR ALL CASES; AND (C) PERMITTING THE DEBTORS' CLAIMS AND NOTICING AGENT TO MAINTAIN THE MASTER MAILING MATRIX**

1 Having reviewed the *Debtors' Emergency Motion (A) Approving The Debtors Filing A*  
2 *Consolidated List Of Fifty Largest General Unsecured Creditors In All Cases; (B) Approving The*  
3 *Debtors Filing A Consolidated Master Mailing Matrix In All Cases; And (C) Permitting The*  
4 *Debtors' Claims And Noticing Agent To Maintain The Master Mailing Matrix* [Docket No. 20];  
5 the Declaration of Richard G. Adcock filed in support of First Day Motions [Docket No. 8]; and  
6 the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein in accordance  
7 with 28 U.S.C. § § 157 and 1334; consideration of the Motion and the relief requested therein  
8 being a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); venue being proper before this Court  
9 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § § 1408 and 1409; due and proper notice of the Motion having been  
10 provided; it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; the Court having  
11 determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their  
12 creditors and all parties in interest; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases  
13 set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; **and for the reasons set**  
14 **forth in the Court's tentative ruling [Doc. No. 113], which the Court adopts as its final ruling and**  
15 **which is incorporated herein by reference;** and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court  
16 and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

17 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 18 1. The Motion is granted in its entirety;
- 19 2. The filing by each Debtor in each of their respective cases of the identical list of  
20 the 50 largest general unsecured creditors is approved;
- 21 3. The filing by each Debtor in each of their respective cases of the identical  
22 Consolidated Master Mailing List is approved;
- 23 4. The Debtors are authorized to prepare and maintain with their court-approved  
24 Claims and Noticing Agent, and to make available upon request, the Master Mailing Matrix<sup>1</sup> in  
25 electronic format, identifying their respective creditors and equity holders on a consolidated basis,  
26 in lieu of maintaining a Master Mailing Matrix for each Debtor.
- 27 5. This Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.

28 <sup>1</sup> Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings set forth in the Motion.

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6. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to the implementation or interpretation of this Order.
