**ORDER SETTING EXPEDITED HEARING**

ON THIS DATE the Court considered the *Request for Expedited Setting* (the “Request”) filed by PlainsCapital Bank (“PlainsCapital”). The Court finds that (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Request pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); (iii) proper and adequate notice of the Request has been given under the circumstances and no other or further notice is necessary; and (iv) the record herein after

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due deliberation thereon, good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief as set forth herein. Accordingly, **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** as follows:

1. The Request is **GRANTED**. A hearing on the following motion (the "Hearing") shall be heard on **September 10, 2020 at 2:30 p.m. (CT)** before the **Honorable Edward L. Morris, United States Bankruptcy Judge**, at the 501 W. Tenth Street, Courtroom 204, Fort Worth, TX, 76102 (**all appearances will be via WebEx according to separately-filed notice**)

- *Expedited Motion of PlainsCapital Bank to Continue Hearing on Motion of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors Seeking Entry of an Order (i) Granting Leave, Standing, and Authority to Commence and Prosecute Certain Claims on Behalf of the Debtors' Estates, and (ii) Related Relief [Dkt. No. 477] (the "Motion to Continue")*<sup>2</sup>

2. PlainsCapital shall give notice of the Hearing by forwarding a copy of this Order or a notice of hearing by the most expedient means available, including electronic transmission, or otherwise by Federal Express Overnight or United States Priority Overnight Mail, to all parties described in the Request and shall evidence such service by filing of a Certificate of Service with the Court prior to the scheduled hearing.
